SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...referring to a pie. (Laugh.) Will what I've described be a pie, as most people understand a pie?

SENATOR REDFIELD: Probably not, in most people's understanding. Although the English do put onions in their pies.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I read...I was coming down here, one time, and they were talking about pumpkin pie, and they eat pumpkins in England, I don't know how, but they don't make pies. So this one person was talking about having tried to make a pie, but it was so lumpy and hard to eat, so they apparently just cut the pumpkin in pieces and put in a pie plate and put it in the oven. Now this bill, if it has as many different...I'm...please, Senator Redfield, now I'm getting to the issue. If this bill has as many differing kind of elements as the ones that I had been discussing with reference to a pie, do you think that could make a bill unwieldily, in terms of trying to administer it?

SENATOR REDFIELD: Well, it probably depends on whether you're talking about a pie, or you're talking about a stew. I mean there are some really good stews that have a lot of ingredients. So I think we can look at the analogies.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: See, you switched on me. I...it was my analogy, I said a pie, now you want to make it a stew. Thank you, Senator Redfield, you're awfully slippery here this.... She was as slippery as goose grease on that one. But here is the point that's being made, they have to go to a different analogy to justify this bill. And I understand Senator Redfield's cleverness. If you would take the time, anybody, to read this bill, and most people won't, you would lose your way in trying to go through it in determining exactly how it's going to be administered. Certain things are made unlawful, but there is no mechanism...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.
