SENATOR CHAMBERS: Here's what I'm asking,...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Is that right? All right, so,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...why...why should I even bother with all of that, when the penalty for carrying a concealed weapon is a Class I misdemeanor? That's the current law, you haven't changed that. If you go to page 41 of the green copy,...

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...starting in line 28, and continuing to page 42, this is existing law that I'm reading, which is not changed. "Carrying a concealed weapon is a Class I misdemeanor."

SENATOR JANSSEN: Um-huh, that's true, that's the way it is right now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So why should I even go through all of what you're talking about?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, I wouldn't go through it, if I had to...if I had to lie on my application. And I don't believe anybody...anyone else will either. They will continue to...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Just carry a concealed weapon.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...carry the weapon. Right, yeah, at...but they can also...they can be arrested for that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Didn't you say, Senator Janssen, that a whole lot of people out there in the country are carrying concealed weapons anyway?

SENATOR JANSSEN: I believe they are.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: They're not being arrested for it, are they?
