SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I really don't know.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Just a moment. Senator Schellpeper, would you move to another microphone, please. Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: 'Cause I usually look a certain way, and I thought my angle was off. Senator Schellpeper, the question I'd asked, and I heard your answer, but it didn't come over the mike, are there people in your area now carrying concealed weapons?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I really don't know, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. So you're not one of those who says that people are carrying concealed weapons anyway out there,...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Well,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...generally, we know some might.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: ...I think they are, but I don't know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, you don't know. Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. See, that's the way it is when you talk about Nixon, after he goes down, nobody voted for him. Now nobody has said that people are carrying these concealed weapons. But I swear that I've heard that on the floor, and I think my colleagues have, too, that people are carrying them anyway. Now nobody has said that, and I'm going to take their word for it. Nobody is carrying concealed weapons, and that makes my argument now. See, had they acknowledged that people are carrying concealed weapons, they could say, that's why there are not a lot of crimes out there and people are not being bothered, because everybody knows everybody's carrying a concealed weapon. But now that they say that's not the case, we have this situation, people are not carrying concealed weapons, they have
