starting point for looking at new expansions and whatever new expansions they can do. Wouldn't that be accurate?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, and so all I'm saying is you should treat previous expansions that are in process the same way as you're treating new facilities. In other words, for an expansion that may exist out there right now, if the application has been put in and is deemed complete by January 1, 1999, that will be the starting point for that facility, whatever it is after that expansion. And that would be, you know, the same thing for new facilities.

SENATOR SCHROCK: But your amendment says January 1st of 2000.

SENATOR BEUTLER: No, my amendment just says "new" and adds the word "and expansions to existing". It doesn't say anything about a date.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Which amendment are we on here?

SENATOR BEUTLER: (AM)1039.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Oh, we're on 1038, so... Okay.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, well now we have the right amendment in front of us here. We're on AM1039, is that correct? Does the Chair concur?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: That's correct.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Okay. And on page 2, line 22, after "new" insert "and expansions to existing". And I think this amendment we would concur is okay.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Are you finished, Senator Schrock?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I am.
