

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Let's go inside and outside, both. If I'm inside.

SENATOR BEUTLER: If it's...if you're on the inside, this amendment wouldn't affect you because you would...you would be...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...under the other rules that we're making here.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: If you're on the outside then it would affect you in the sense that with regard to class III, IV...if you're a class II, III or IV operation, in your new operation you would not be...you would not be allowed to take that waste and bring it over into the protected watershed and apply it to the land there.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: What if you have contracts with individuals on the inside of this water...you know, inside of this...in the watershed? If you...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, this...this would only apply to new ones, so it would mean you can't enter...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...into those contracts.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Also, if you're a class I, then you can spread your waste inside of...or in this watershed.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah, right now under this bill, unless I'm forgetting something, there would be nothing that would prohibit a class...I mean you can start a new class I inside the watershed so, certainly, you can start one outside the watershed and there are no rules anywhere in this bill about class I's, so they wouldn't be affected one way or the other.
