transactions as to nonconsumer goods transactions so that there is some drafting errors that are caught. For example, licensee is changed to licensor. Officer is changed to office. The striking of an internal erroneous reference, and to make technical corrections and an appropriate change to the repealer provisions. Those are the committee amendments. I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendments. I believe Senator Coordsen has an amendment on behalf of the ag fertilizer groups around the state. We will have a chance to talk about that forthwith, but I'd ask for the adoption of the committee statements so...committee amendments so that we can get on to that larger issue. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Landis. Your light is on, if you wanted to discuss the committee amendments. Okay. Is there any discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Landis, would you like to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes, and closing on the committee amendments to LB 550, you will have heard about an issue on this bill but it's not in the committee amendments. It will be taken up I think immediately by Senator Coordsen and we'll get on to that issue once this piece of business is finished. I'd ask for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, record.
