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SENATOR COORDSEN: Only to the extent that Senator Landis talked about it in the several conversations that he's had with us, and that when this particular revision of the Uniform Commercial Code was made of this section that those who participated, who are unknown to me, representing the commerce of agricultural lenders didn't raise any objections to the language that is included in the form of 550 presented to us. I don't know who those people were. I only know that after this bill was introduced that there were agriculture supply businesses who did register an objection and there are those who did not register an objection in the hearing and then after it was advanced from the...to the floor.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Senator Brashear, you're recognized to speak.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Madam Chair, members of the body, I'd like to, first of all, say how appreciative I am of Senator Landis bringing LB 550. The importance of a uniform Uniform Commercial Code to Nebraska and all of its citizens in terms of our commerce and our participation in a national and global economy is...cannot be overstated. But having said that, with regard to the Coordsen amendment, I wonder if my friend Senator Landis would acco...no, not accommodate me, would you oblige me and could we engage in a little colloquy here?

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Senator Landis, assume, and I'll try to make this brief, but I want to try and illustrate a point, and I may be wrong, and then I'll be pleased to have you tell me. But assume a prosperous agricultural economy and no Coordsen amendment and the banker is totally underwriting the agricultural operation and he has what I call a wraparound priority security interest, and bad times come. And the banker, at that point, or the lender is in, so-to-speak and I'm sure it would all be appropriately done, but complete control from a leverage standpoint to decide whether or not we are...the agricultural producer in these now emerging bad times is
