SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bromm, would you respond?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes. Thank you, Senator Crosby, and that's a good question. First of all, the people that are going to be doing this are...are trained and this is a...the training they receive is a federal requirement and they have to meet those...

SENATOR CROSBY: Oh.

SENATOR BROMM: ...standards before they can...

SENATOR CROSBY: Before they could examine.

SENATOR BROMM: ...give the test.

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay, and then there was...it seemed like there was other one. There were two places about commercial drivers. The third party testing is the same...is that the same thing?

SENATOR CROSBY: The same, that the federal...the federal law would apply?

SENATOR BROMM: Okay, which page are you on, Senator Crosby? You're looking at the handout.

SENATOR CROSBY: Yeah.

SENATOR BROMM: And of the handout, if you could tell me what section?
