SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time. Senator Cudaback and Senator Connealy announce that they have the following guests visiting us this morning. They are Wally and Audrey Rose from Gothenburg. They are Senator Connealy's mother and father-in-law. They are under the south balcony. Would you please stand and be recognized by the Legislature. Also visiting us this morning, several of us have guests in the north balcony. They are 85 representatives from the Council of Catholic Women statewide and they are in the north balcony. Would you please rise and be recognized by the Legislature. Welcome. I guess they were also under the north and the south balcony, excuse me. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. I have a few questions to either ask Senator Jones or Senator Bromm, which whoever would like to answer them. And it deals with the portion of the bill that you can get your driver's license in any county, not only the one that you reside in. And the questions I have are what portion of that driver's license fee remain in the counties? Senator Jones, I'll address the question to you, if you can answer that, please.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Jones, would you respond?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, thank you. The portion that remains in the county is \$3.50 for a five-year license. That's what we're going to go to anyway.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right, so that...now the next question is in some of the outlying counties I realize that it would be more advantageous for someone to get their driver's license in the county seat where they're closer to rather than where they live.
