SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I need to visit with Senator Bromm a minute again, please.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bromm, would you respond?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes, yes, I would.

SENATOR DIERKS: Senator Bromm, before noon we advanced the first part of this amendment, is that right?

SENATOR BROMM: That's correct, Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: And that dealt with line 5, 6, and 7 on page 2?

SENATOR BROMM: That's correct.

SENATOR DIERKS: And I think I asked you at the time, before we advanced that, if the commercial truck drivers had signed off on this amendment?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes.

SENATOR DIERKS: Now I should ask you who is the commercial truck driver that signed off on this?

SENATOR BROMM: The person testifying at the committee, and who suggested that this would be an acceptable solution was Mr. Cuca.

SENATOR DIERKS: Mister, who?

SENATOR BROMM: Bud Cuca.

SENATOR DIERKS: Well, I had a phone call, just a little bit ago, from a commercial trucker in my district, who...who was not happy about that. And I told him I'd visit you a little bit about it. But I wanted you to know ahead of time that they'll probably be contacting you, because they just have problems with that. So it's a commercial truck driver from my district, he's...
