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operator license provisions, again, to a large extent, in preparation for the changes that we're going to be making in the driver's license process in the future. So, thank you, Mr. Speaker. If there are any questions or any specific sections people would like to discuss, be glad to try to respond to those.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, and, Senator Bromm, I'm trying to coordinate what we're doing here. And when I look in this...on the sheet that we have, the first part of it mentions that LB 588 is the bill, and we would find Section 12 on page 11, and on page 11, I believe, Section 60-4,114 is being amended. But that section is not amended by LB 588, nor is, when we get down to Section 18, 60-4,144 I don't think is amended by 588, page 14. I'm trying to look at the bills where these sections came from to see what was done with the bill and what portion of the bill it is. Maybe it doesn't make any difference, so maybe I'll just let these ride. And then when the amendments are adopted and become a part of the bill, then I'll have time to go through them. But I don't believe Section 20 is in error. Section 20 on page 20 says it comes from (LB) 589, and I believe it does, the section that's amended,...

SENATOR BROMM: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...the section of statute.

SENATOR BROMM: I'll...I'll check those two or three prior to that further and see if we've got the wrong reference in the left column, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. But...but in reading the amendment in the committee amendments, I don't see anything in the committee amendment that causes me any type of alarm. So at this point I don't have any objection to what I've gone through in terms of all but the last two sections, which would be 26 and 32.
