SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Mr. Clerk, an amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend.  
(See AM1063 found on page 1286 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Beutler, you're recognized.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Wickersham, members of the Legislature, this is an amendment that Senator Dierks knew was coming and understands why it's...why it's going to be in the bill. The compact law requires that, in order to set into motion the five-year withdrawal period, that it's necessary for the Governor of our state to give notification to the governors of the other compact states of the fact that Nebraska has withdrawn and that the withdrawal is in effect. That sets into motion the time, the five-year time period of withdrawal. And so all this amendment does is to add that notification direction to the Governor to give notification to the other governors, and is merely a technical amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Kristensen, do you wish to speak to the...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Schrock, do you wish to speak to the amendment? Senator Dierks, do you wish to speak to the amendment?

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. President, I do. I just want to say that the amendment is totally acceptable and I have no problems with it. So I would urge the body to accept the amendment. I should tell you before we go much further, I passed out a little handout for you. It answers most of the questions that I've been asked over the last few months, and I think the answers are very easy to understand. If you have questions about that, just ask me. Thank you.
