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of the committee amendment. Floor amendment 82 on the last page is a section that we will be on first this morning. So thank you, Madam Chair, and any questions, I'll be glad to get started.

SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Bromm. We'll start with the first divided...division of the committee amendments. Discussion on the first section, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, last night I had the opportunity to look at this bill and I find some serious problems with it, so I would like to begin by asking Senator Bromm some questions on the division.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bromm, will you yield for a question?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes, Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Bromm, we're on, by page number, 4, to locate you where we are, it would be FA82. In line 27, we have the word immobilization, and then definitions of what that term will mean. When we get to the subsection (a) or subdivision (a), it says "the removal or impoundment". Let me ask a question on those two words first. What is the difference between removal and impoundment in this language?

SENATOR BROMM: Yeah. Removal would be taking the vehicle, I would assume, to a different location. Impoundment would be retaining the vehicle in a specific location.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, if they...

SENATOR BROMM: ...and, Senator Chambers,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh...

SENATOR BROMM: ...I need to have my staff check the federal regulations on that to see if there's any implication for those words, which there is. In the federal regulations covering this area, in the definition of "impoundment or immobilization" it
