happens under Senator Coordsen's provision. If we'd make it truly a unitary system across the board, then you might have me on your side, and I'm going to offer amendments to do that. But since I only have one minute and we're on a different aspect of the bill, I won't go into it right now, but it's hard to restrain myself. I'm going to ask for a call of the house and I'll take a machine vote on this amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There's a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please record your presence. Would those unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Matzke, would you like to check in? Senator Preister, would you like to check in? Senator Wickersham, Senator Janssen. Senator Stuhr, Senator Schrock, the house is under call. All present and accounted for, the question is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to the committee amendments to LB 585. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of the amendment to the committee amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. Raise the call.

CLERK: Senator...
