SENATOR CHAMBERS: Based on language further down, is that right?

SENATOR BROMM: In the amendment you mean?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR BROMM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And all it says is, it is...and I'm looking in line 8, "it is unlawful for any person to consume alcoholic liquor". Is that what it says?

SENATOR BROMM: And that is...yes, and that's current law.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Now, it does not say the liquor has to be in liquid form, does it?

SENATOR BROMM: Liquid form?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR BROMM: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So, if liquor were in a cake and it were consumed in that form, it would be illegal, under this provision of law, wouldn't it?

SENATOR BROMM: Is this the fruitcake exemption?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, or other cake.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It would be illegal, wouldn't it?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes, it would.
