SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of this portion of the divided committee amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Senator Jensen, for what point do you rise?

SENATOR JENSEN: For those coming into the Chamber, the board is...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Jensen, I...if you're going to request a roll call vote, that's fine. In terms of once we've started, we're not going to debate, once we've begun to take the vote. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: The point is the board appears to be incorrect. We are not voting on an amendment to the amendment by Senator Chambers. We are voting on this section of the committee amendments, and that's confusing some people. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bromm, thank you, and, Senator Jensen, I just wanted to make sure that we don't debate when we're doing that. Senator Bromm, would you please come forward, and Senator Chambers. I want to make sure I understand what portion we are voting on before we take the vote. We will stand at ease. Senators, we did announce that we were voting on the third portion of the divided committee amendments. That's what we've been voting on. The board is still open. I will allow the board to remain open if you want to switch your vote. There was confusion on the message boards but the announced vote was this portion of the divided committee amendments. Vote for aye, if you want to, or vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 15 nays on that component of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: That portion is not adopted. Mr. Clerk.
