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something about these health issues.

SENATOR COORDSEN: One minute.

SENATOR KIEL: Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Kiel. Senator Chambers, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, again, I speak very strongly in favor of this bill. When Senator Bourne's little boy was back there saying "hi" to everybody, he reminded me that the last time he was here he heard me say, I like women, and now that's what the little one wants to say. Actually, that was an understatement. I love women. Senator Hudkins, I've often told people who tried to make me a religious person and get me in heaven that it would take so much grace to save me that it would be a waste because I still wouldn't be saved and there'd be nothing left for anybody else in the world, so they better leave me to my own devices and utilize that where it will work. Well, if the love that I have for women could be equally divided among all of the women who ever were, are, or will be, no woman would ever feel unloved or unwanted ever. Now that gives you an idea of my position. I think of situations in history, like Joan of Arc, burned alive at the stake. Older women, because they got osteoporosis and people didn't know what it was, were deemed to be witches. Older women, who were more in tune with nature and would use medicinal herbs to bring about healing and surcease not only of pain but of sorrow, were deemed to be witches. There is no medical procedure which has been discredited related to the health of women. There is no medical procedure which is now discredited which ever made a mistake on behalf of mitigating suffering and pain. They always increased a woman's pain, deprived her of certain treatments, or said that because she brought sin on the world she shouldn't have the benefits of it, such as anesthesia. That was for men but not women, and in some countries they still will not allow women to use anesthesia when they're going to go under the knife for surgery. This bill would talk about a coherent, coordinated, comprehensive approach to the health of women. Every time a bill of this kind is brought up in any Legislature on the state level or even the
