CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Stuhr would move to amend.  
(FA93, Legislative Journal page 1323.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Stuhr, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. What I'm moving is on page 5 of the bill, to strike lines 1 through 5, which is in regards to hiring an executive director and also employing additional personnel. The...it would strike unto the word or the period after "initiative". It still then leaves the opportunity, as stated below, for the Governor's Policy Research Office, Department of Health and Human Services, and other state agencies may provide administrative and technical support under the direct supervision of the Governor. So it still does allow someone to direct the initiative, but does remove hiring an additional executive director. Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. You've heard the opening on the Stuhr amendment. Senator Landis, your light was on before. You want to be on the bill. Okay. Thank you. Senator Schimek, to speak to the Stuhr amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Stuhr, may I ask you to reexplain your amendment.

SENATOR STUHR: Yes, I'm looking on page 5...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Right.

SENATOR STUHR: ...of the bill and it would be lines 1 through 5...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And you...

SENATOR STUHR: ...ending with "initiative".

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And you would just delete all of that.

SENATOR STUHR: Um-hum, just delete.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That's what I thought you said.
