SENATOR STUHR: Okay, again, I am saying that there will be a chairperson and a vice chairperson of the council. I do not exactly see what those responsibilities will be.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR STUHR: I know I have...I have served as chairperson in a number of groups and you coordinate the activities, you work together with the people that are on the advisory committee in setting up the guidelines and your priorities on what you wish to accomplish. Again, I'm just introducing this as a choice to eliminate that director for the women's health initiative and let that actually up to the director of Health and Human Services. Thank you, and ask for your support.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease on the Stuhr amendment to LB 480? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.
