SENATOR D. PEDERSON: No.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. Thank you. That's all the questions I have right now.

PEDERSON: If I may, in response, this is also the fact that what we are doing actually is reimbursing the schools for something that they are already spending, so it is...it's not a budget item. It's a reimbursement item and they will not receive 100 percent of what they do but it will certainly make a significant difference in their dollars. Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Senator Raikes, on the amendment to the amendment.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Madam President, members. Senator Pederson, could I address a couple of questions to you? One...

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: No. What...what will happen, mechanically, is that the school districts individually have the option, if they wish, to contract with the Department of Health and Human Services for engagement in this program. If they
