body, and thank you for all those who have showed an interest in this bill. Really, the possibilities are endless. You can treat dermatology, cardiology, psychiatry, ocular medicine, even help in surgical. Some day, I think we're going to be looking at telemedicine home care. Cooperative "tele-ultrasound" is possible now, certainly pathology, radiology, and psychiatry, which is something that can be done very, very well through telemedicine. I would just urge all members of the body to support this legislation and to support the amendment. I think we can do a great service to our friends in rural Nebraska and it is on a cutting edge. They have equipment today that actually you could go into a clinic in Alliance or O'Neill and either through doing a scope down a stomach, somebody, a specialist, can read this in another community and come up with immediate findings. And it's just, like I said, the possibilities are endless. So I would just urge the adoption of, first of all, the amendment, and then we'll move on to the committee amendments and then the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR BOHLKE: There are no lights on. Senator Jensen, do you wish to close on the committee amendment? Senator Jensen waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 559. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
