And with that, Mr. Speaker, I would add that we have had, as a gift to Mrs. Schellpeper, this resolution put into plaque form for presentation at the conclusion of the day, today, during the ceremony. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Seeing no lights, Senator Coordsen, you are recognized to close on this resolution. He waives. The question before the body is the adoption of LR 61 honoring the late Senator Stan Schellpeper. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 61.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LR 61 is approved and will be presented to the family. We next move to motions to return to Select File for specific amendment. Mr. Clerk, LB 90.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR (sic) 90, first of all, Senator Bromm, FA...or, I'm sorry, AM0498. I have a note that he'd like to withdraw that, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: No objection? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bromm would move to return LB 90 to Select File for specific...AM0763. (AM0763, Legislative Journal page 1193.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bromm, you're recognized on your motion to return to Select File for specific amendment.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Colleagues, as you'll recall, LB 90 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Cudaback to try to deal with some problems associated with abandoned vehicles and primarily the focus was to try to give some additional opportunity or, I guess, give authority to the
