enough then to accomplish what the constitutional duties are, then I think it's our responsibility to fund it with the additional money that is needed. But we have not had total confidence, frankly, in...in that this is the right way to approach the matter. So that's why we're doing it in the way we're doing it. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Mr. Clerk, a motion on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Janssen would move to indefinitely postpone 432A.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Janssen, you're recognized to open on your motion.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. It's been brought to my attention that we cannot advance LB 432A as long as 43...or we cannot advance LB 432 as long as LB 432A is still alive, and it cannot...otherwise, it would have to accompany it. And the only way we can do that is to kill LB 432A by indefinitely postponing that bill. So I ask you to vote green on indefinitely postponing LB 432A, which will rectify the situation that I want to obtain. So thank you very much. I hope you all understand this. If you'll vote green, every thing will be just fine, on the IPP.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the motion to indefinitely postpone. Senator Janssen, waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 432A be indefinitely postponed? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone 432A.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 432A is indefinitely postponed. We next move to Select File, LB 54A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Smith, 54A, I have no amendments to that bill, Senator.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith, you're recognized.
