And you have women who, because they're either married or have some special consideration given to them, will ignore the problems that other women are facing, serious problems. And then we have women who will vote against the interests of those women. But let a situation arise where it's to their benefit to appeal to the fact that they're a member of the female gender, and then they will use it with a vengeance.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Your light is the next one.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Madam President, when Senator Schellpeper was last here, nobody saw any indication of ill health in him, I certainly didn't. You know what that proves? We don't know when we're going to check out of here. I don't know when I'm going to croak. I could croak before the sun sets this evening. That could be the case for any of us. And when somebody leaves here we talk about all the things we should have done for that person, but what about the things we're able to do right now for all the other people, not just those that we know, not just those we work with, but those who need our help, those for whom legislatures and governments exist? Why do women have to come crawling in here, begging and showing their wounds? We all know how women are mistreated in this society; we know it, and yet we have to stand on this floor, some of us, and argue as though it's serious that women are discriminated against, and we have to persuade people of that fact. And there are men on this floor who engage in that discrimination, then they'll stand on the floor and say, there is no discrimination, there is no problem for women, let's forget this. Then, if you read the newspaper, a newspaper as lacking as the World-Herald, you will see article after article talking about the physical, mental, medical, financial problems that are confronting women in this society, then I got to stand on this floor and listen without getting angry, without grabbing somebody by the throat, to men saying, well, there's no problem here, women get this, women get that, you're all imagining things, you're seeing shadows where there's no substance. Then women get up, yes, we're finely
