CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The Wehrbein amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. Nothing further on the bill. The question is the advancement of LB 179A to E & R Engrossing. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed. The bill advances.

CLERK: LB 674, Senator Smith, I do have E & R amendments pending, Senator. (AM7089, Legislative Journal page 1122.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 674 to E & R for engrossing. Oh, E & R amendments? Were there amendments?

CLERK: E & R amendments, Senator, I'm sorry.

SENATOR SMITH: Excuse me, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 674.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 674. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Wickersham would move to amend with AM1094. (AM1094, Legislative Journal page 1297.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Madam President. This is probably the simplest amendment that I have brought this year. If you look at page 31, maybe the simplest one ever almost, this is an amendment to the white copy of the bill. It's on page 31.
