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category of persons, be interested in helping others who will not help the category of persons I'm concerned about? I know that some of these starting farmers might be females or there might be females in that family, but I see something of a higher priority than that. Old Satan, when he and God were playing games with Job, had told God, yea, skin for skin, all that a man has will he give for his life. Life is important to individuals. Health is an essential to a meaningful life. And when we turn our back on a program that addresses the health needs of a numerical majority of the population, a vulnerable majority, a discriminated against majority, I am not put in the best frame of mind. So in voting...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...for Ms. Seacrest's nomination, you're not seeing the cresting of my indignation and dissatisfaction, displeasure with what the Legislature has done. I recognize that each of us will make decisions for whatever reasons, but there will be consequences flowing and I am one of those who is always prepared to accept the consequences of my actions.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. For further discussion of the confirmation report from Natural Resources Committee, Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. President and members. It's just a real pleasure this morning to speak about Susan Seacrest. Aside from her gender, she is a highly motivated, imaginative, articulate young woman who...now Senator Schrock mentioned the National Ground Water Foundation. She was the motivator, the organizer, the brains behind this foundation. And it, at the beginning, it was probably just a small ripple in our way of life and it has become an ocean. Activities and projects that Susan Seacrest is the one person who organized people and got all kinds of people to help her. One of the big things they do every year is the migration of the children to Grand Island for the...for the celebration when the Sandhill cranes come back. So I think that from that point of view, aside from the points that Senator Chambers are bringing up, we should be very grateful to her, as Nebraskans, because of her recognition of the need for the Ground Water Foundation and her continued
