those who cannot feel another's pain and be moved to do what we can to alleviate that pain, it may be necessary, speaking by way of analogy, naturally, to give them a bit of pain. Then they will better understand. But, brothers and sisters, I'm not going away. I'm not going to let these issues die. And I'm going to look at how we do the rest of our business for the rest of this session.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I am going to support this nomination. One other thing I have to say, I hear so many white people so busy talking about how inferior black people are, and I'm so busy reading all of these laws that exist because of a dysfunctional white society, that's why the statute books are written. That's why the Internal Revenue Code is so thick and so complex. That's why we have the Uniform Commercial Code to stop these white people from dealing dishonestly with each other. Those things are not written for us. The things written for black people are those laws that allow discrimination and denial of equal protection of the laws. But, brothers and sisters, we're going to sled from now to the rest of the session. Will it be smooth or will it be rough? Time will tell.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Seeing no further lights on, Senator Schrock, to close on the report. Senator Schrock waives closing. The question is, shall the confirmation report presented by the Natural Resources Committee be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on the confirmation report, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal page 1395.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: The confirmation report is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.
