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isn't a terrible lot of support in our county to the university, there is, but it's a source of real acrimony and real dissatisfaction when it comes to property tax and why...why us and why isn't that burden shared in some fashion by the public who benefits from the public purpose. In the case of the MUD well field, the public of Omaha and its entities that it serves will benefit from that public purpose, not a bit of benefit will flow to Saunders County, not one bit that I can see, but we will have thousands of dollars removed from our tax rolls. Now I'm not sure how we address this. I have lots of questions, too, about the bill. I have a question about what a lease is, which maybe sounds like an elementary question, but I can see lots of creative ways of circumventing the lease provision and whether or not that will be attempted or whether or not a defin...a clearer definition of lease needs to be inserted. I don't know yet but I am very concerned about the bill, about the workability of the bill. The idea and the concept is a good concept, but whether or not we have the details worked out to our satisfaction or whether we can remains a question. So I will continue to listen to the debate. Those of you asking questions are asking very good ones and this bill definitely needs the three stages of debate as it moves through the process. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Chris Peterson, on the amendment.

SENATOR C. PETERSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. Senator Wickersham, we're going to keep you busy this morning, and I have been in a conversation with you regarding what we consider the public purpose. There had...during the public hearing, there were some questions about narrowing or enlarging or how that definition was. We had been in the middle of your discussion on the public purpose, would you continue with that, please.
