SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Smith. Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Call the question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question before the body is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on ceasing debate on the Wickersham amendment, AM1204, to the committee amendments to LB 271. Have you all voted who wish to? We are voting on ceasing debate, AM1204 to the committee amendments. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Debate does cease. Senator Wickersham, do you wish to close?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Mr. President. The specific amendment that you're going to be asked to vote on is a technical amendment, so I hope that it can be adopted without a great deal of controversy, although it's quite clear that the underlying committee amendment has some issues for a variety of members. But the amendment that you're going to be asked to vote on now, 1204, I think is largely technical in nature. I don't recall anything from the discussion that we held thus far that would indicate for any reason that you should vote except to adopt AM1204, so I would ask that you do so.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. The question before the body is, shall AM1204 to the committee amendments to LB 271 be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
