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person in my community that I've read about who's deemed a gangster that I would have as much unwillingness to meet on a dark street as I would cops. I'd rather deal with the crooks. I'm on the streets at night. Crooks don't bother me. But anyway, I've got to show Senator Byars and his ilk that we're talking about something more than seat belts, although that's all he wants to talk about.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. (Visitors introduced.) (Inaudible) discussion on the Chambers amendment, Senator Connealy.

SENATOR CONNEALY: Thank you, Madam President. I'd yield my time to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Connealy. Madam President and members of the Legislature, so that it's clear what this amendment would do that I'm offering, Senator Byars wants to up the penalty on this violation by including the assessment of a point against a person's driver's license whenever that person is stopped by a cop and cited for not having a safety belt and the person is convicted of it, but would probably go ahead and pay the ticket rather than have to pay court costs and spend time off work. You pay the court costs anyway, but would you want to pay lawyer fees on top of that? Certainly not. So Senator Byars knows what he's doing. He knows that he's assuring that anybody who gets one of these tickets is going to pay it. Then that will make the statistics. But if they stop me, I'd fight them like I do on these speeding tickets, which I win. I lose in the county court. I lose in the district court. But where it counts, in the Supreme Court, I'm the one who says "mate," meaning checkmate. So I would fight them. I'm the one, who, with all the grumbling in the legal community and the public at large about these red light cameras they were going to have that photograph people's cars, nobody would undertake to do it except moi. I did it, because it was so wrong. I wouldn't get photographed because I don't go through red lights. I don't run stop signs. But I know how these things are misused, and when they are laws in violation of the state constitution I will take action. This that Senator Byars is attempting to do is a
