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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, yes.

SENATOR JONES: They would be...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Livestock,...

SENATOR JONES: They would be able to lease the whole stock?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, whole...and...

SENATOR JONES: The whole kaboodle?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes,...

SENATOR JONES: Okay. Well,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...instead of breaking it up,...

SENATOR JONES: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...or, or a factor of that, or you know a part of that.

SENATOR JONES: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: You could do...

SENATOR JONES: They would have to be able to...agree to get along, because at the end of the three years, your machinery might have a...be broke up some, too. You'd have to kind of be concerned about that, too.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yeah, that would have to be part of it. I mean there's kind...there's these deals out there now, I would assume, where somebody is coming in and doing. But this gives the incentive for an older farmer to do that, because there are some downsides to him wanting to do that. And hopefully an income tax credit will be an incentive.

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I can see where it would be an advantage to the older person. I just don't see no real big advantage to the
