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then the full positive view of the Wehrbein bill as proposed.
Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Brashear amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further to the committee amendments at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: We're debating the advancement and adoption of the committee amendments. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Wehrbein, let me explore with you how this would work.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And I think I'm suffering some confusion, because I don't understand how leases and those things work out there sometimes. But as I understand it, the heart of the bill would be Section 18, which provides for the credit which goes to the owner of agricultural assets, that is it goes...the credit goes to the lessor.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is that accurate, so far?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And the rent has to be a prevailing community rates; the board oversees that to be sure that's not jacked around. And then the credit is allowed...it has to be rented to...to a qualified beginning farmer with a written lease agreement. Now, right now, out in the countryside, would it be
