fair to say that most of the beginning farmers are sons and daughters of people who are already farming?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I suppose, yes. I don't know the familial connection, but I would assume probably.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Is this bill intended to be available to those beginning farmers, or are those beginning farmers excluded by some provision of the bill or another?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: You cannot be a family member, in this case, to be in this. This has to be nonfamily members.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. So...and is that provision under the definition of what a beginning farmer is? Is that where that is?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We're looking for it right this minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. There is some language on page 20, line 10, that says, "the applicant seeking assistance from the board shall not be currently engaged in farming or livestock operations with a family member that already possesses agricultural assets to provide the individual or other family members engaged in farming or livestock opera...production the opportunity, et cetera. Is that the provision that..."

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: There is...
