SENATOR BEUTLER: Which line is it on?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Line 7 on page 20, but I don't know whether that will be true in your...in yours.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Anyway, let me read it: is not a relative, as defined in this section, of the owner of agricultural assets in which the beginning farmer or livestock producer is seeking to enter into a share-rental agreement. So that's the line that takes that out.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so...so the beginning farmer cannot be a relative of the...of the owner of the assets that benefits from the credit.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right. And by "relative"...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It's defined in Section 36-702.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, in 36-702?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And what is that definition?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I'll have to look at it. (Laugh.) I don't have it at the tip of my...I don't have it right here, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. So, the most...who would be the most likely group of people to whom this would appeal?
