SENATOR CHAMBERS: Unfortunately, Senator Tyson, I was in another discussion about the bill, but I wasn't following what you had said.

SENATOR TYSON: Okay. Essentially what I said, Senator Chambers, is that 43-247, subdivisions (3) and (4) of that law, include abused, neglected children as well as criminal violators.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR TYSON: Now then, the way I read...do you have this up on your gizmo?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, but what...are you looking at the committee amendment?

SENATOR TYSON: I'm looking at...I am looking at AM1261, I'm looking at Section 3, which strikes the words "the care of some suitable institution, (2) inpatient or outpatient treatment at a mental health facility or mental health program."

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm not looking at the same amendment you're...I'm looking at AM0717. You're looking at a different one?

SENATOR TYSON: Okay, it's the same on page 3...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I'm looking at that.

SENATOR TYSON: ...and look at line 18 and...18, 19, and 20.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR TYSON: Now, what I'm saying, Senator Chambers, you tell me if I'm...I'll take your word on this, I'm saying that if you take all of that language it...that language, the stricken language, removes the child, the minor child, from the immediate purview of the judge and gives it to, if you'll look down on lines 26 and 27, to the care and custody of the Department of
