SENATOR THOMPSON: ...they were able to do it. We now...the reason I was off the floor is there is a section that, because of the amendment to that amendment, there's going to be another version of this, and I apologize but it's...it's kind of technical...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...and confusing. So there are some sections that were accidentally left out and we are going to go to a third version of this amendment as soon as it gets back down here, which will solve all the problems. So the things that you're detecting, because you looked at the difference between those two, are going to be addressed, and what we.. what...what we should have...what we should have when we get done, (voice fading) I'm sorry, I guess I'm...I don't know if I'm too short or too tall, but what we will have with the version is the agreement with the department and the counties on the first amendment that we've already adopted to the committee amendments and that should look just the same then, plus the committee amendments will have amended out of them LB 472 and all the interested parties from the department, the counties that were in the back have now worked with Bill Drafters and we have that cleared up.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, I think, and I was becoming comfortable with AM1250 but...and I don't know whether I want AM1261, but I'm going to tell you what I am interested in and we'll see if we're getting close to what I would...

SENATOR THOMPSON: Good.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We leave the Omaha secure facility under...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...Corrections' control. Perhaps a new...a facility will be available that will be somewhere between...the difference between Kearney and Omaha Corrections, that's...I think that's what you're talking about, that will be under control of OJS. Kearney would continue as it is under some
