for a master plan. I...my other question will be what is Kearney to be used for under this future and what amendment will this be in? The one that is still coming down from Bill Drafter, will that be where we're headed?

SENATOR THOMPSON: No, this...this amendment deals only with secure confinement and...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...by "secure confinement" that particular facility has a perimeter fence, it is...it is a locked facility. Kearney and Geneva are staff-secure facilities.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right. I understand.

SENATOR THOMPSON: So this...but when, just for point of clarification, this would provide secure confinement. The facility plan looks at both nonsecure and secure...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...confinement.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: The plan.

SENATOR THOMPSON: So...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...the plan does and the money that would fund that. If, for example, the recommendation of the facility plan is that there should be a new facility built at the girls facility in Kearney and most of the, if not almost all the youth, I presume, that would go to the secure facility are going to be male, so there would be a potential for a new facility to be built to serve girls and...

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...that could be funded out of the budget, supported by the two-cent cigarette tax that supports the
