SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...and would not have...be under the oversight of that department.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. I think I'd agree with everything you're doing. I want you to know how...I just want to know how we get there with amendments that we've had and I think the body would like to know that too.

SENATOR THOMPSON: And I appreciate that. This is very confusing and I think it kind of matches up to the juvenile justice system itself. (Laugh) It's very, very confusing to sort through. But there are many levels of placements for juveniles. We're dealing with secure and staff-secure types of facilities in these bills and that's where we go today.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Do you expect a substitute amendment for AM1261?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes. This...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And then that will become the main bill or the main amendment?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Committee amendments.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Right. Actually, what it will do is the committee amendment, the other portion that we have not debated is the portion that discusses county costs and we've touched on it in other discussions here but there are three areas we've talked about in this bill. One is the secure facility in Omaha, which we've agreed not to transfer back...
