CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Bohlke's amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The Bohlke amendment is adopted. Now we go to the discussion...back to the discussion on the committee amendments. Seeing no lights, Senator Wickersham, would you care to close on the committee amendments?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Madam President. I will be brief, just to say that the committee amendments are now the amendment offered by Senator Bohlke, and as you supported that amendment, I hope that you will support the committee amendments. I also wish to note that, for some obscure and unclear reason to me, it is apparent that this issue takes a woman's touch. Senator...it was noted that this bill was introduced a year ago. I could not get the bill out of the Revenue Committee. This year it comes out without any dissenting votes and is apparently going to be passed by this body without any dissenting votes. Senator Bohlke and I have to spend some time in a car together this afternoon later. I'm certainly going to ask her what she did different. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. The vote...the motion is on the committee amendments. All in favor of the committee amendments vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Committee amendment is adopted. Discussion is on the advancement of LB 539. Senator Vrtiska.
