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from 5 cents to 6 cents on that. On property taxes, what is one more penny added? Nothing, but you imagine the kind of screaming that would occur if that happened. But when we want to support something which is harmful to society, what's a penny here, and what's a penny there? Why, nothing. This is one of the worst bills, not the worst, one of the worst because it brings out the worst in people. They rationalize, they temporize, they change the meaning of words, they shave principles, they cut corners to make it seem like everything they're doing is all right. Well, I'll make a deal with you all. You all made a deal with the devil when you agreed to pass a lottery into state law and let the state get involved. Leave the Native Americans alone, and I'll leave the white people alone. Can you get Monahan to leave the Native American's alone? If you get him to leave the Native Americans alone, I will leave the white people alone. And I'll say, have at it, gamble as much as you want to. At least the money that they get is used to alleviate terrible conditions of grinding poverty, ignorance, disease, lack of housing, unemployment. And the city...the U.S. Attorney can prosecute them, and with a vengeance, but when it comes to white people's games, well it's just going from 5 cents to 6 cents, and my colleagues want to get that 6 cents. If it's just a penny, at least Judas got 30 pieces of silver for selling out. I wouldn't sell out for a penny. One penny. To save my colleagues, I'll give each one of them a quarter. I'll give you each a quarter to salvage your principles and the integrity of this Legislature. Yeah, that's what we're talking about, the integrity of the Legislature. A Legislature is more than just a genteel debating society where we go along to get along. We talk about the nitty-gritty of things that affect this society, and when we are involved in that which is personal, we need to have our number called just like everybody else. We just got through, not too long ago, talking about those who sell and deal amphetamine because as far as we know nobody on the floor of the Legislature does that, so we can really go after that. If we were talking about heroin or stealing cars or drive-by shootings, we could really sink our teeth into that. Or outright stealing, we could sink our teeth into that.
