Yes, only to say, only to reiterate now that the, on line 20 with Senator Chambers' amendment, you scratch out "at least" and add "no more than" six. That's the only change that there is in the committee amendments at this time. So the rest of it is...the rest of it is intact, and with that I ask you for the passage of the committee amendments. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: You've heard the closing on the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Senator Janssen, did you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR JANSSEN: I respectfully ask for a call of the house. I think some people have left again and a roll call vote, please.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: There's been a request for a call of the house and a roll call vote. All in favor of calling the house vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The house is under call. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Will all members please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Matzke, Senator Jones, please return to the Chamber, the house is under call. Senator Jones, please return to the Chamber, house is under call. Members, please return to your seats, the house is under call. We are all here. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. Legislative Journal pages 1465-1466.) 13 ayes, 20 nays.
