She played a key role in seeing that the radio station, KUCV, which was once located at Union College, became a part of the Nebraska Public Radio Network. There's much additional evidence of the public service contributions she made. She was an original member of the Postsecondary Coordinating Commission. She worked tirelessly on behalf of the Lied Center and my wife pointed out to me that she was instrumental in seeing that a child-care center was established, which was a joint operation between Saint Elizabeth's Hospital and what is now the Gallup Organization here in Lincoln. Bill, as Senator Bohlke mentioned, is a now-retired surgeon, but he has also been very active in public radio and television and a number of other public service activities, including the Lincoln Symphony. So I would certainly add my endorsement to what Senator Bohlke has mentioned. Thank you.
