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those particular systems. I think this will provide a much better, more accountable system, and one that will provide to the Department of Education the ability to make those situations well at the time they need to be made well. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Seeing no other lights, Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, Mr. Speaker and members. Once again, I just thank you for listening. The amendment certainly, I think, stays with the commitment and the original intent of the bill, but certainly makes some changes that were in response to issues raised on the floor, and a commitment Senator Cudaback and I made to working those out before we got to Select File. And so with that, I ask for your support of the amendment and then your support of the bill. Thank you very much.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. Question is the adoption of amendment AM1259 to LB 314. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bohlke's amendment.
