SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes. And he put his hand up and I called your attention to it and you said later.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Beutler, did you request you would accept call-in votes?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I did.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: I'm sorry. I did not hear you. Call-in votes will be accepted.

CLERK: Senator Connealy, voting yes; Senator Wehrbein, you had voted yes, Senator?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Would those members not excused please record your presence.

CLERK: Senator Chris Peterson, voting yes; Senator...

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to LB 573, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 573 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 573. The question is the advancement of LB 573. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced.
