SENATOR CROSBY: Any discussion on the motion to approve the Committee on Committees' report? Seeing none, the question is the motion to approve the Committee on Committees' report. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the report as offered by the Committee on Committees.

SENATOR CROSBY: The motion is approved. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the first bill this morning, LB 505, a bill originally introduced by Senator Landis. (Read title.) The bill was discussed on April 13, at which time committee amendments were adopted. I have a priority motion this morning. Senator Landis would ask unanimous consent to bracket LB 505 until May 14, 1999.
