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client's call took just say two hours, and I would say that would even be a minimum of what we...what we usually experience. I'll...I'll look at that here in a minute. The other is certainly the cost of N-FOCUS and that's the other thing, I hope, Senator Brown, you'll talk about. I've asked Senator Wehrbein what we have spent so far and, for those of you who weren't here, in, I forget what year, '94 or '95, I carried the welfare reform bill and we talked about N-FOCUS. We have now spent \$41.9 million on N-FOCUS and it's not...it's not adequate. And so, is this additional money that we are going to be doing to upgrade N-FOCUS that...or are we going to implement a new system? So those questions, Senator Brown: how the caseload that...the scenario I've laid out; the money we've spent for N-FOCUS, if this will be an addition to N-FOCUS. And then, most importantly, if...if the two-day turnaround time is not met...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BOHLKE: ...then what? What accountability is there for the new establishment of these workers to meet those guidelines, and how will the state be held accountable? And those would be just some of my initial questions. I haven't made up my mind yet on this bracket motion, but I wanted to summarize the discussion I had had with Senator Brown before and that I'm sure all of us here, I think, want to get the money to the clients as quickly as possible. That should be our main goal. If there's anything that's going to be a hindrance rather than a help, I think it's time to analyze it, discuss it, and do what we can to prevent that being from an...being an eventual outcome. I realize that I think it has some benefits right...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time.

SENATOR BOHLKE: All right.
