know what the other alternative is, which is, if we don't do something by October, we are facing some financial responsibility that I don't know whether we want to say, well, we were right on the issue, but it sure did cost us all a lot of money to be right. So, and I probably represent the toughest district in the state because it's my district judge that has led the charge in this matter to say don't do this, my clerk of the district court, and all down the line, they have all said, we don't want this. And I don't want it, but I think we've got it, I think we have to do something with it. So, for that reason, I will object to the bracket motion. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Pederson. Senator Engel, on the bracket motion.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the body, I, too, was at this ALEC meeting with Senator Pederson. Talked to this gentleman from Ohio and other states. And, of course, they paid the penalty, and then of course they also signed up to comply. So they went through the two processes there, and both...of course the one costing them money. But I've always been for more efficient and effective child support collection and enforcement. I think we've had too many people across the country and in our state that have not been...taken care of their responsibilities. That's not the point here. But as far as I'm concerned, this is federal blackmail, there's no question about that, we've been through that process before. When I served on the county board and the school board, I always...I felt that way sometimes about the state of Nebraska also. Here comes the dollars, but there are always strings attached to those dollars. So any time we accept dollars, you just have to expect those string coming out. I think the only way we're going to change this, I'm not going to say I'm in favor of this bill, I'm not in favor of the bracket, because I would like to, like Senator Bromm, I think we have to do something. We have to come off of dead center. But the only thing is the only way we're going to change this federal blackmail, and talking to our colleagues at ALEC, from all across the country, the only way we're going to do that is Senator Chambers quoted LBJ, I do this with heavy heart. Well, I'm not doing this with a heavy heart. I like to quote another Democrat, Harry Truman, like tell them to go to hell. But the only thing is, one state, can we do that
