resolved by that October deadline. That's probably true. And I think it's important that on this issue we do address it correctly, because we are talking about people, we are talking about lives. And I think Senator Brown has come to us with an issue and with a concern, the issue is time in turning money over to the mothers and their children who need it. She's also talking about a separate issue, which is the fact that the federal government is going to withhold dollars. Now I'm one who believes that the mouse can roar very loud. And I don't mind losing the dollars, if it's important to do that. But I think that we have to be very careful in discerning the issues here, looking at where we stand, not trying to kill a bill that we could fix, not trying to fix a bill that should be killed. But, Senator Chambers, if you would yield to a question, please.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Senator Chambers, I'm confused as to your intent. Is your intent to kill the bill, or is your intent to fix the bill in time?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It is to do away with the bill entirely and maintain the present system that we have. The only way I could get this before us was to offer a bracket motion to a day certain. It becomes a priority motion and allows for the discussion that we're having now without delaying it.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Is there a reason why you would prefer not to just go to a vote today and try to accomplish that with the debate now?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I don't know when...how long it would take us to get to that vote, because I don't know what amendments would be offered or any other tactics that may be used against the bill. The bracket motion will have to come to a vote, because you cannot amend it. So when the debate on the bracket motion is over, a vote will have to be taken on that, up or down. And, if it's successful, when I talked about studying it, I didn't mean this bill, I meant the issue of the current system that we utilize. And if there are corrections that are needed, like the
