With that, thank you, Mr. President, and I'd give the remainder of my time to Senator Chambers, if he'd like to have it.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Chambers, just a little over two minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Brown, I would like to ask you a question. Senator Brown, how did we get from 8 million to 15 million to \$1.4 billion that we will lose if this bill is not passed?

SENATOR BROWN: Senator Chambers, I never said that we would lose 1.4 billion. What I said is that we accept \$1.4 billion in money from the federal government, most of which has strings attached to it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, then let me...

SENATOR BROWN: If we are being consistent, we need to be consistent across the board.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, I don't agree with that. It's like saying one container has poison, the other one doesn't; if you're not going to drink the poison out of this container then don't drink the nutrients out of the other. But...
