SENATOR BROWN: Senator, I've heard you say that the...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...here's the question that I...

SENATOR BROWN: ...Roads stuff is poison too, so...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...here's the question that I want to ask you. Let's say that this system is in place. A woman does not get her check. What is the first thing she does? Who...whom does she contact?

SENATOR BROWN: She would contact the central unit.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Wherever that happens to be located.

SENATOR BROWN: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: With whom will she speak?

SENATOR COORDSEN: One minute.

SENATOR BROWN: She will speak with one of the persons that would be hired under the fiscal note of this bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And what will that person do?

SENATOR BROWN: Rectify the situation as quickly as possible.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What steps will that person take to do so?

SENATOR BROWN: Check the records and find out what the situation is in terms of whether the money has come in and...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Where will these records be located that this person is going to check?

SENATOR BROWN: Well, the records will be on a computer in each one of the offices in the counties, but also in the central disbursement unit.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And the records in the counties will be
